

Jesus and the End Time | Author's Profile Data

There follows a brief description of the author's education and professional credentials, and a listing of some of the many U. S. patents he obtained for clients during almost 30 years of practice as a patent attorney.

While the author's formal education in religious and Bible studies is limited to religion classes he took at parochial schools, he has studied the Bible and books on related subjects on his own for many years. In addition, he worked for many years in fields that required him to analyze complex electrical and mechanical systems, determine their true nature and purpose, and those of its component parts, and then describe them and how they differ from those of the most nearly similar systems that existed before they did. In the process he acquired skills that put him in a good position to study the End Time teachings of Jesus described in the New Testament, determine their true nature and meaning, and those of the words they use, and then clearly describe them and how they are related to those of the most nearly similar End Time teachings of the Old Testament. In the Jesus and the End Time website the author presents the results of his study of these teachings, free of charge, to anyone willing to spend the time necessary to read them.
